

200. i2b2 Wizard

Summary

The i2b2 Wizard is a tool for installing and administrating an i2b2 server in a Linux environment. While i2b2 is easy to use, it is not so easy to install and maintain. There is an official [installation guide](#) made of 15 chapters, but the i2b2 Wizard tries to automate some of the steps for you. The whole feature set is described in the [introduction](#).

First, you need to [download all required files](#). In case you want to make a test installation, we advise you to [create a virtual machine](#) image.

Then you have to install the Linux operating system, exemplary shown for [Ubuntu 14.04 LTS Desktop Edition](#) (Ubuntu Linux [Server Edition](#) requires two additional steps).

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
