

Use Case 2_ Patient id, num and map_ids are not mapped

In this case, the <patient_id> source and value ('EMPI' / 1000000) is already mapped to a PATIENT_NUM, but the <patient_map_id>s are not, so use that PATIENT_NUM for any of the <patient_map_id>s that are not already mapped.

Example:

```
<pid>
<patient_id source="EMPI">1000000</patient_id>
<patient_map_id source="MGH">123</patient_map_id>
<patient_map_id source="BWH">777</patient_map_id>
</pid>
```

The rows in the PATIENT_MAPPING table **before** the update:
