3.3.2 Define Physical Memory


In your i2b2 Workbench directory there is a file called i2b2workbench.ini and it is in this file that the physical memory for the i2b2 Workbench is defined.



Important

This section only applies to Microsoft Windows and it is **optional**. You do not need to edit this information to run the workbench only if you wish to change the default settings.

- 1. Go to YOUR_I2B2_WB_DIR and open the folder called Windows.
- 2. Double click on the i2b2workbench.ini file.



2. Edit the value of Xmx to be equal to the amount of physical memory on your computer. The default setting is 480m.

Example: Scenario: your computer is running with 1GB of Ram

Default Setting: -Xmx 480m New Setting: -Xms 1024m
